Each Scout: **Required Equipment**

CLOTHING - No Cotton

- * Waterproof bags for clothing
- * Long Johns: Synthetic, top & bottom
- * Underwear
- * Inner socks; Polypro or equiv
- * Outer socks: Heavy wool or equiv
- * Balaclava
- * Stocking cap; wool or synthetic
- * Inner gloves/mittens; 2 pr, wool or equiv
- * Outer mittens; waterproof
- * Extra gloves: warm & waterproof
- * Boots: Sorels with felt liners, winter mountaineering boots (waterproofed)
 - * Wool shirt or equiv
 - * Sweater, polar fleece or wool jacket
 - * Pants; polar fleece/wool/powder pants
 - * Hooded parka: waterproof
 - * Rain pants: waterproof
 - * Gaiters
 - * Handkerchief(s)

PERSONAL GEAR - No Cotton

* Matches: waterproof or strike anywhere in waterproof container

- * Flash light with extra bulb & batteries (head-lamp leaves hands free)
 - * Sunglasses or goggles
 - * Sunscreen
 - * Lip screen
 - * 50' 1 /8- nylon cord, red if possible
 - * First-aid kit, personal
 - * Repair kit
 - * Snow shoes or XC skies and poles
 - * Snow saw
 - * 15"x15"x1/4" plywood sheet

 - * Backpack & waterproof cover
 - * Emergency food: not candy (24 hrs)
